A meeting of the Newville Borough Fountain Festival Committee was held on Thursday, May 28, 2022 at 7:00PM in the Newville Borough Office, 4 West Street, Newville, Pennsylvania. Members present: Joe and Liz Knouse, Jim Burkholder, Clarence Fry, Joey Diehl and Bob Kanc. Carolyn Kough was absent due to an illness.

Update since the last meeting:

- There are 14 craft vendors, 15 community service organizations and 5 food vendors registered. The size of the festival will be reduced significantly from previous years. We NEED MORE FOOD VENDORS.
- Scott Donato will serve as the Master of Ceremonies for the parade on Friday night and he will provide the line dance. Judges will be Joey Diehl, Bob Kanc and Irv Nelson.
- Bob Kanc: Kiwanis will help line up the parade,
- Joey Diehl: She is working on the poster contest.
- Cathy Graver: Will be purchasing 100 prizes for the duck derby at 5 Below. The senior center will provide judges for the baking contest. She needs an auctioneer to sell off the baked goods after the judging. She is working on face painting for the children.
- Mike Fry: Will help Cathy with the duck derby. Tickets will be \$1.00 each.
- Joe and Liz Knouse: The reenactors have canceled as they are now going to Bedford, PA. Their garage is still available to stock the water, soda and ice. A half skid of water was donated thanks to Kathy Lloyd. Soda will be \$2 per can, \$1 for water.
- Jim Burkholder: WEMA will mark out spaces on W. BSA, Parsonage and West St. The east end of BSA is empty as of now. WEMA will escort in the vendors on Friday and Saturday, provide a balloon light on Friday night.

 - Pony rides on Saturday by Winsome Farms

 - Big Spring Heights Church of God will supply teenagers for the soda and water stand in turn for a donation to help their vacation bible school.

 - Library will have a book sale on Saturday
 - Carolyn has sent invitations to the county and state dignitaries inviting them to the parade on Friday night.
 - T-Shirts provided by Piper Advertising are still on sale.
 - Due to a shortage of volunteers there will be only one soda/water stand this year.
