

NEWVILLE FOUNTAIN FESTIVAL COMMITTEE
MEETING OF
APRIL 14, 2022 AT 7:00PM

A meeting of the Newville Borough Fountain Festival Committee was held on Thursday, April 14, 2022 at 7:00PM in the Newville Borough Office, 4 West Street, Newville, Pennsylvania. Members present: Carolyn Kough, Clarence Fry, Jim Burkholder and Fred Potzer.

Carolyn Kough reported:

- The Zembo Shrine Mini-Cars will be participating in the parade. Cost is \$300.
- The Klinger McFry Band, now down to three members will play on Saturday, June 18, 2022 from 12:00PM to 3:00PM.
- Chuck Egger is organizing the 5K run scheduled for Saturday morning.
- Baking contest entries will be judged at 9AM on Saturday morning in the borough office.
- Carolyn has asked Judy Hockensmith to take charge of volunteers for the water and soda stand.
- There will be a water and soda tent in the food court with two water/soda boxes. There will be only one central location for drinks. The change was made due to a lack of volunteers.
- The committee will sell a 25th Anniversary T-Shirt in two colors, based upon the design provided by Joe Piper of Piper Advertising.
- The Newville Lions Club is unable to sponsor the porch decorating contest this year as the club has a 75th anniversary planned for the same weekend.
- We need 2-3 teenagers to work the water and soda warehouse and to make deliveries. If anyone knows of someone willing to work Friday and Saturday, please contact Carolyn Kough.
- In lieu of a porch decorating contest the committee will sponsor a 25th Anniversary poster contest for children.

Mike reported:

- The Duck Derby tickets will be sold at a cost of \$0.50 each. There will be approximately 100 prizes.

- Five food vendors, eight craft vendors and eight community service vendors have returned contracts as of April 14, 2022. Many are return vendors.
